Jet Cards

How do jet cards work?

Jet cards are simply a set amount of flight hours that you pre-purchase. As you'll be paying in advance and buying in bulk, you'll likely be able to save quite a bit when you invest in a jet card. The number of hours you can purchase will vary. Some cards are set up so that the hours you purchase are only able to be used on one specific type of plane, but others will provide more options.

What kind of commitment does a jet card require?

One of the biggest benefits of a jet card is that you do not have any long-term commitments. Jet cards allow you to use the service with far less stress. When you purchase a jet card, you are purchasing a select amount of hours that you will be able to use over a set course of time. Therefore, you will know what you have available upfront and be able to plan accordingly.

Do the hours purchased on a jet card expire?

This will vary depending on the specific program and jet card you purchase. When you purchase flight hours on a jet card, you will be able to see what expiration date is assigned to those specific hours, if applicable. For the hours that do expire, that time frame typically ranges between 12 and 36 months, so often, clients have plenty of time to use them. However, if your flight needs are sporadic and you're not sure if you'll be using them all before any applicable expiration date, jet cards may not be the right fit for your needs. Some options will allow you to roll over unused hours or transfer them to a

new program, but that is not always guaranteed.

Is there a minimum flight time required on flights booked with a jet card?

Some jet cards have a flight time minimum whereas others do not. Expected minimums, where applicable, can be around 90 minutes or so. If your flight time is going to be less than that, you will typically still be able to charter the flight but you may have 90 minutes (or whatever the minimum is) deducted from your total. If you're flying long distances regularly, this may not be a problem, but it is still an important consideration to be aware of.
